

Recipe of the Month

My mother would make a great dessert if we were having leftovers for 2nd time. This was a favorite of mine and it sure beat canned fruit cocktail.

1/2 C Butter

1 Cup Sugar

4 Eggs

1 tsp Vanilla

1 - 1/4 Cup sifted All Purpose Flour

3/4 tsp Baking Soda

16 oz. chocolate syrup (like Hersheys)

3/4 Cup chopped Walnuts

ONE BOWL CHOCOLATE CAKE SYRUP CAKE

Grease and flour a 13" by 9" pan and set oven at 350 degrees.

Cream 1/2 cup butter or margarine with 1 cup sugar together until light and fluffy.

Add 4 eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.

Sift 1-1/4 cups sifted all-purpose flour, 3/4 teaspoon baking soda together & add alternately with 16 ounces chocolate flavored syrup (like Hershey's) to the creamed mixture.

Add 1 teaspoon vanilla; mix well. Pour into the prepared pan. Sprinkle top with 3/4 cup chopped walnuts.

Bake at 350 degrees for 40 - 45 minutes, or until done.

Any leftovers will stay moist and fresh for days. No icing necessary, as velvety-moist.
