The Run for Ricky commemorates the life and untimely death of Ricky Silvia, a former Taunton State Hospital employee and Taunton resident who heroically saved the life of a drowning young boy from a frigid pond but lost his own life in the action. To recognize this act of selfless courage and bravery and to foster the ideals of healthcare professionals, the hospital awards three \$1,000 scholarships to employees or their children seeking to attend college. 
International Affairs:

Community Improvement:


