The program this month was Julie Lovely from the Wild Hearts Horses for Heroes; who work with Veterans with PTSD, a Non-Profit Organization in West Bridgewater,

Massachusetts. They help to transform the lives of their participants, families, and all who work with them through the healing power of horsemanship. Wild Hearts also offers one-onone EFP sessions with their therapist, EFP an experiential form of therapy that allows the client to engage in activities with a horse that illustrates the dynamics that the client experiences in everyday living. This experience provides opportunities for the client to learn about themselves and new ways to cope with their everyday life. Participants gain horsemanship skills, forge an indescribable bond with their horses, and simultaneously address life and coping skills. their un-mounted Healing through Horsemanship program touches lives in ways never thought possible. She was very informative and had a video for us to watch about the ways a former veteran has been helped through this program and now helps others.
