September Meeting:


The president of the month was Denise Wheeler. It


was on Monday October 5th at the USMC League Hall, 265 High Street in Somerset. The meeting was outside. The small number of members brought their own


Brown 261 Hart Street Dighton, MA 02715. The drawing will be on October 14th and Nancy Brown will deliver your winnings to you on October 15th.
